



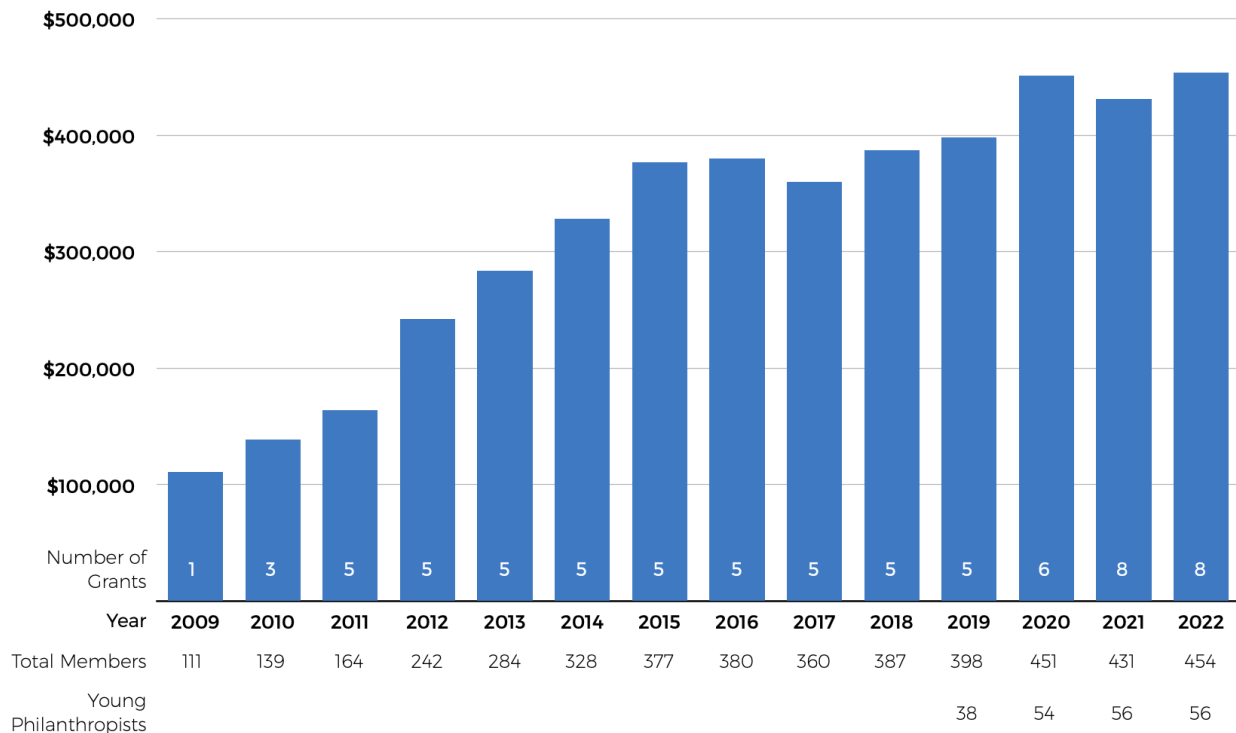
# 2022 Annual Meeting

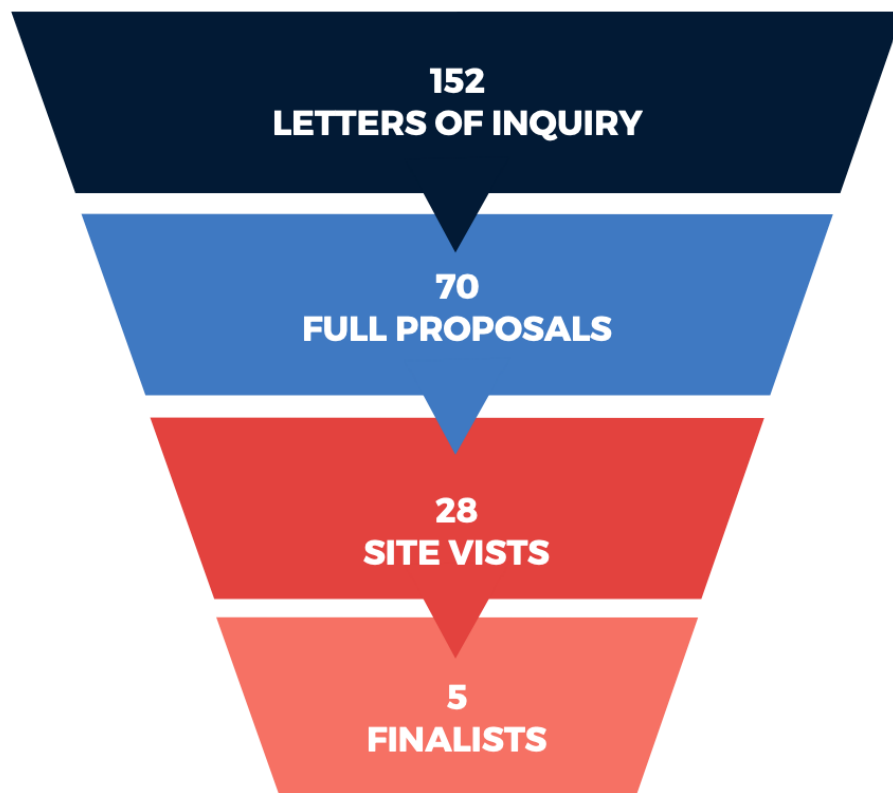

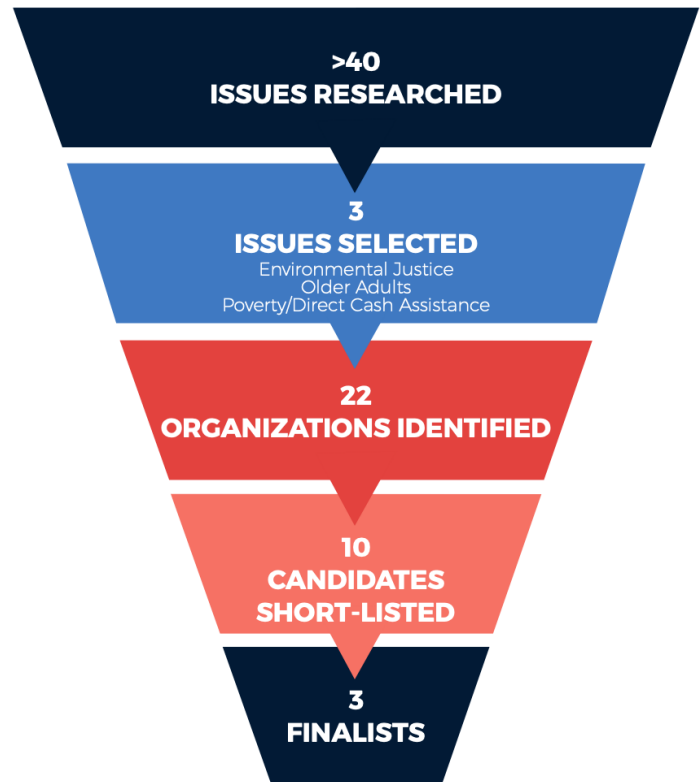

## 2022 COMMUNITY AWARDS - \$35,000 IN FUNDING

Impact100's Community Awards program began in 2021 as a two-year pilot program, modeled on trust-based philanthropy. The intention is to be broadly inclusive of the nonprofit community and support a more diverse group of smaller nonprofits addressing critically important needs, while eliminating the burden of proposal-writing.

In 2022, the Community Awards Committee (CAC) of fifteen Impact100 members conducted research and outreach to identify award candidates. From an initial list of more than 40 suggestions, they identified six areas for deeper review through independent research and outreach to member, nonprofit, funder and community contacts. Ultimately the CAC selected three issue areas as the focus for 2022: Environmental Justice, Older Adults, and Poverty/Direct Cash Assistance.



In the second phase of its work, the CAC identified 22 candidate organizations, honed that list to 10 for deeper review, and ultimately selected our 3 Community Award Finalists to receive one award of \$15,000 and two awards of \$10,000.

This work has given our membership a deeper awareness of our region's needs, and has extended Impact100's funding to be even more inclusive and community-based.

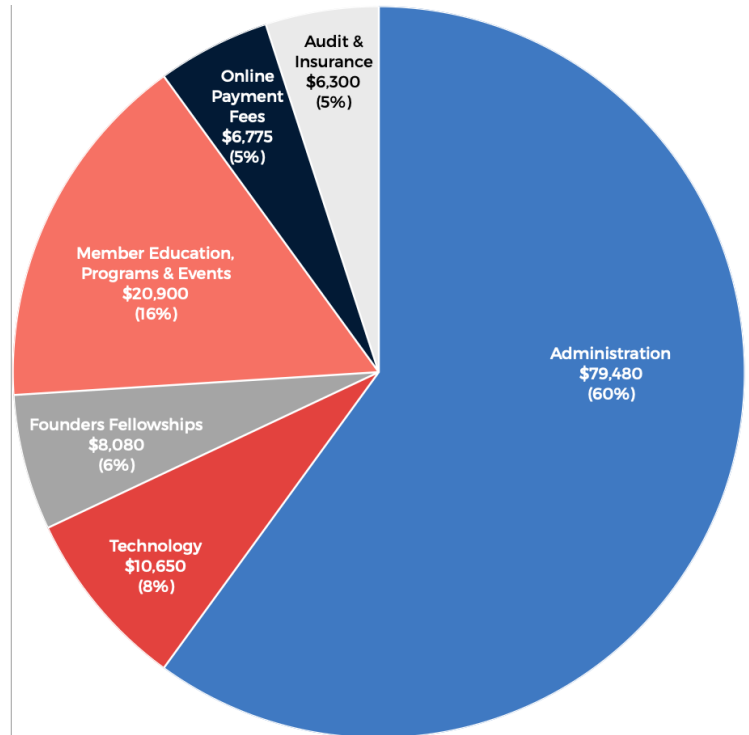
## IMPACT100 FISCAL 2022 OPERATING EXPENSES
